Eligibility

- 1) The applicant must be a current undergraduate of the University of Malaya.
- 2) The applicant must be a citizen of Malaysia.
- 3) The applicant must be currently pursuing a first degree (full-time), with a minimum CGPA of 3.00.
- 4) The applicant must have a household income of less than RM 5,000 per month.
- 5) The Award is open to students in all disciplines. Preferred disciplines include:
 - a) Computer Science and Information Technology (to amend as per name of course in the University)
 - b) Business Management / Accountancy / Economics (to amend as per name of course in the University)

Terms and conditions

- 1) The successful Study Award recipient must maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.00 every semester.
- 2) The Award recipient is required to work with other Award recipients on a community service project.
- 3) Deutsche Bank is not obliged to provide Award recipients with an internship or any future job opportunities.
- 4) The Award recipient consents to Deutsche Bank using his/her name and/or photograph as part of our internal and external communication, including media releases and publicity material.
- 5) Deutsche Bank reserves the right to terminate the Study Award immediately without notice if:
 - a) The Award recipient fails to abide by the terms and conditions set out herein and/or any other terms and conditions as may be advised by Deutsche Bank from time to time;
 - b) The Award recipient commits a criminal offence or is found to have committed a disciplinary offence against the University's Statutes and Regulations;
 - c) The Award recipient participates in activities or acts in a manner which is, or is likely to be, adverse to the interests of Deutsche Bank, or which cause, or is likely to cause, embarrassment to Deutsche Bank
 - d) The Award recipient's candidature at the University of Malaya is terminated for whatever reason.
