Despite the challenges encountered during rehearsals, the ensemble members have shown remarkable dedication and resilience. Their determination and teamwork have shaped them into an inspiring group of performers. Under the expert guidance of Mr. Ngoh Heng Seng from the Singapore Chinese Orchestra and Mr. Augustine Chong, they continue to grow musically and emotionally - bringing energy and heart to every beat of the drum.

The group has showcased their talents at events such as the "COLOUR YOUR WORLD" concert in 2018 and the "Love Our Libraries and Archives (LOLA)" event in 2023.



Beautiful Mind Charity Singapore

Beautiful Mind Charity Singapore (BMC) is a philanthropic organisation founded in 2012 with a mission to promote cultural exchange and social harmony through music. BMC works closely with underprivileged communities and individuals with special needs, empowering them to grow both artistically and personally.

At the heart of its outreach is the Beautiful Mind Music Academy (BMMA)—an inclusive education initiative that supports children with special needs. . With the support of musicians from the Volunteer Guitar Connection (VGC), they work tirelessly to overcome physical challenges and bring their passion for music to life on stage.

MDAS and VGC have collaborated on many events, including ones organised by dbEnable, and the Purple Parade, spreading a powerful message of inclusion and resilience through music.



dbSing (Deutsche Bank Singapore Choir)

dbSing is a volunteer choir formed in 2023 by employees of Deutsche Bank Singapore, united by a shared belief in the power of music to connect communities and promote inclusion. The group brings together colleagues from across business functions – many of whom had no prior choral experience.

Under the direction of choral conductor Kenny Khoo, dbSing has grown in both confidence and cohesion. Their debut performance at Deutsche Bank's dbDiversity Celebrates Christmas 2023 marked the beginning of their journey, and they have since continued to lend their voices to various events across the bank.
